- Youngest and veterans team based on average age
- FIDE Rapid Rating upper limits for Team: (Any board order)
 - Player 1- Any rating
 - Player 2- Max. 1800
 - Player 3- Max. 1600
 - Player 4- Unrated only
- Any number of Unrated Players allowed in a team.
- No Substitutes allowed.
- Fixed board order for all rounds.

GENERAL TOURNAMENT RULES

- Swiss format. Total rounds as per number of players/ teams.
- Walkover time: 25mins (Long Rapid), 3mins (Blitz Clash), 15mins (Team Battle #5)
- **Under-15 (born on/after) 01/01/2011**
Under-12 (born on/after) 01/01/2014
Under-09 (born on/ after) 01/01/2017
- Latest FIDE & AICF rules will apply. In case of any disputes during the tournament, Chief Arbiter's decision will be final.
- Any kind of wristwatch or electronic devices strictly not allowed. In case a player found cheating, strict disciplinary action shall be taken alongwith immediate disqualification.
- **In case of player entry cancellation, ₹150 shall be deducted** as admin charges and rest of the entry fee shall be refunded. (₹400 in case of team cancellation). This refund is valid till Thu 28th May, 6pm- after that no refund on cancellation)
- Prizes will not be shared. The latest tie-break rules will be applied in case of a tie. Only one highest prize will be awarded to each winner.
